## UNITED STATES OF EUROPE

“...To build a kind of United States of Europe”

Winston Churchill

As a classical liberal, I have always opposed Western identity politics. I am also a lifelong critic of Islamists. I endorse Kemalism within the context of Turkish politics: the ideology of Turkish Europeanists.<sup>1</sup> I oppose communism, which *necessarily* evolves into imperialism. I oppose racism against people of colour, especially violent racism, keeping in mind that Whites have the inalienable right to maintain a majority in their homelands. For example, The European Court of Human Rights has dismissed the argument that Western nations should “accept *entire populations* from the developing world, countries at war or those ravaged by natural disasters.”<sup>2</sup> This should not mean that all refugee rights, nor all asylum rights, should be abandoned.

I am supportive of Taiwan’s struggle against CCP (Communist Party of China). While I am somewhat critical of past European colonialism, keeping in mind the historical context, I disagree with attempts to vilify the European Union through “human rights imperialism.” The United Kingdom needs a reversal of Brexit,<sup>3</sup> perhaps even a conservative reversal,<sup>4</sup> in keeping with my original arguments. I do not endorse ICC pressing war crime charges against the United Kingdom,<sup>5</sup> nor Australia,<sup>6</sup> over the Iraq War. I am agnostic about ICC investigating the United States over war crimes in Afghanistan, while I endorse ICC’s investigation against black

box torture sites in Eastern Europe and elsewhere. I support the emergence of Nigeria as a rising middle power. I also support India becoming a future superstate. I am supportive of Russia rejoining the jurisdiction of the European Court of Human Rights. I want Turkey to join the European Union. I endorse a two-state solution in Israel and Palestine. While I am critical of Zionism, I firmly believe in Israel's right to exist. I oppose Holocaust denial, as per Council of Europe law.

The European Union has changed for the better over the last decade. Back in 2018, with a nominal GDP of \$16 trillion and at the cusp of Brexit, the European Union was in great danger. European revanchists who threatened to exit Europe (Grexit, Frexit, Nexit) have stopped voicing such claims since. EU's GDP is now \$23 trillion, GDP-PPP \$30 trillion. The European Union has signed defence treaties with Switzerland,<sup>7</sup> UK,<sup>8,9</sup> Canada<sup>10</sup> – and is building Paneuropean troops.<sup>11</sup> Support for reversing Brexit now hovers around 60%.<sup>12</sup> The International Criminal Court has now pressed war crimes against Israel, United States, Russia – ever the prosecutor.

While I am critical of postclassical feminism, especially in the United States, by no means do I endorse violence nor exploitation towards women. Women should have the vote everywhere, and I am not opposed to female leadership in politics. *“War is genocide against men.”* Without opposing Forever Wars, it is impossible to defend the rights of men. Both in Syria<sup>13</sup> and Ukraine,<sup>14</sup> for example, female civilians are less likely to survive than male civilians – and female civilians are more likely to survive than their children. Men are the majority of homeless people, prisoners, death row convicts, stateless people. Men are the minority of college students in the United States. Scholarships worth tens of billions of dollars in the United States, earmarked for women only, were abolished thanks the work of a

small team of activists (including myself). I am agnostic about American “culture war” clichés like gay marriage and abortion. I oppose the criminalization of male homosexuality across the planet. I believe human population decline is a very serious concern. I oppose the criminalization of sex workers.

I oppose war crimes of every stripe, no matter what and no matter when. I have communicated with the high courts of Europe many times about such war crimes. I am a person of interest to the International Criminal Court.

**(2014)** Sending evidence about the persecution of African Christians (and the persecution of Turkish democrats) to the International Criminal Court because of Erdogan’s Islamist foreign & domestic policy,

**(2018-2020)** Sending evidence to the European Court of Human Rights, International Criminal Court, European Court of Justice, and the International Court of Justice about the “lab leak theory.” That is to say, I maintained that COVID-19 was a viral agent developed by the Chinese Communist Party, which was released by accident. The virus in question was (I argue) developed by Charles Lieber and Shi Zhengli. CIA endorses the lab leak theory.<sup>15</sup>

**(2022)** Sending evidence to the European Court of Human Rights about Jewish extremism in the United States, which led to the publication of *Baldassi v. France* – which decriminalized boycotts against Israel across Greater Europe.
